Please review this confirmation carefully & let me know of any changes; do not wait until the night before or the day off. We ask your co-operation & assistance to ensure that all days run efficiently.

Be ready on the line, have collars unbuckled and give your dog's name clearly to the scribe. Care has been taken to give people running multiple dogs' sufficient time between, therefore there should be no reason to make changes to the running order, but we will be understanding.

**Handler's responsibility:** It will be the handler's responsibility to check off their dog on the gate list upon completion of the walk throughs. Gate Stewards will be demanding and will not go looking for handlers. We ask that the next dog and handler be on the line when the judge asks, collars and leashes off & ready to proceed at the sound of the "GO"

Entry to the fun run can be done via email. ([theiss@rogers.com](mailto:theiss@rogers.com)). Time will be 65 seconds. There will be a buzzer at 50 seconds as a warning, and the second buzzer at 65. Toys & food can be used during the fun run. Food can only be used under very strict guidelines. No food can be thrown, can only be handed directly to the dog. Toys containing food cannot be used as tug toys. These toys can be used, but leave the food out. NO food that crumbles. NO over flowing pockets or containers allowed, bring only a few treats that will be used during the time. Course maps for classes after the fun run must be held until the completion of the fun run. These numbers are **as at Monday, April 9th**

There will be changes due to additions, move-ups and cancellations.

**Registration** & Measurement 7:30 a.m. but other arrangements can be made. A check in list will be available for you to confirm that your dog's information is correct. Due to the new jump height effective January 1<sup>st</sup>, you will be required to check in and show your AAC height card for verification. **Food:** There will be no food vendor at the facility. The Town of Orangeville is about 10 minutes drive away. **The food supplied will be for trial helpers/workers only.**

**Walk Throughs:** All walk throughs will be timed to a 7 minute maximum. These times will be strictly adhered too, the timing systems buzzer will sound at 7 minutes.

**Crating:** Crating of dogs will be allowed at ringside along the walls or in the balcony area. There will be ample crating available, **with the use of the balcony area.** However, there will be a lot of dogs, your co-operation is appreciated in stacking crates & using the balcony area. **Please take care to keep all dogs quiet when there is a dog in the ring.**

**PARKING RULE:** All cars are to be parked in the parking lots of the facility. The driveway and road outside the building is a fire route and must be kept free of all vehicles. Please be considerate and leave an area for unloading on the roadside in front of the green man doors and then move your vehicles to the parking lots.

**ALL LOADING and UNLOADING must be done via the back doors only.**

**PLEASE NOTE: No access through the front doors.**

**ABSOLUTELY NO DOGS ARE TO BE EXERCISED AT THE FRONT ON THE BUILDING** or walked through the lobby. Please remember other groups use this facility at the same time. The human washroom facilities (**no dogs allowed pleased**) are in the building. Please keep all areas clean and **always pick up after your dogs**, garbage cans will be available, if caught not picking up future entries will be refused. **REFRAIN from using the garbage cans inside the building for liquid garbage, this makes taking the garbage bags out unpleasant and very messy.** **Take water, coffee, pop etc, to a sink or outside.**

**Assistant Required:** **We appreciate everyone's help.** In order to shorten the days for everyone, we will require patience, flexibility & assistance from competitors to help with the setting of bars, leash running & score sheet running etc. Offering your help and assistance, will make the days run smoother & end quicker. Please check the worker's list for your assignments **for those who did not check of the "helpers" box, but meant to please jump in if I call for volunteers.** We would greatly appreciate bar setting help in a couple of the classes through the day, watch for "volunteer needed" on the workers list posted. **REMEMBER THE MORE YOU HELP THE MORE TICKETS YOU GET for the workers draw.** There will be a workers draw towards the end of the day
